WHEREAS, the month of April is known for recognizing Alcohol Awareness and the California Friday Night Live partnership, a positive youth development program dedicated to fostering leadership in young people so they can advocate against drugs & alcohol, and

WHEREAS, Committed, a campaign established by the Council on Alcohol and Drug Abuse(CADA) is facilitated by the Santa Barbara County Friday Night Live program to allow youth the opportunity to plan prevention activities for their peers in order to promote a drug-free lifestyle, and

WHEREAS, The mission of CADA to build a safer, healthier community by preventing and treating alcoholism and drug abuse. CADA supports families, youth and adults through our prevention, education and public awareness programs in addition to providing treatment and referrals.

WHEREAS, the goal of the CADA, the Friday Night Live program, to encourage families, schools, businesses, media, government, medical institutions, faith based organizations, law enforcement agencies, and other youth to foster an atmosphere that supports a healthy lifestyle for youth, and educates and creates awareness of the harms of substance abuse, and
