Resolution Setting Forth Conditions For Use of the Manning Park Youth Center Resolution No._____

WHEREAS, Santa Barbara County (hereinafter "County") is the owner of the Manning Park Youth Center (hereinafter "Center") located on the County's real property, identified as Assessor Parcel Number 009-060-051, and commonly known as Manning Park (hereinafter "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Center was constructed in the early 1900's and served as a carriage house for the Manning Estate, which Estate was dedicated to the County in 1935 for park purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Center has traditionally served to support youth activities; and

WHEREAS, the County occupies the first floor space within the Center; and

WHEREAS, the County has designated the second and third floor space within the Center for youth programs provided by community not-for-profit organizations for the purpose of conducting educational or recreational activities for youth such as meetings, training sessions, day camps, and other related activities; and

WHEREAS, the County is committed to operating and maintaining the Center in a manner that supports youth activities and is compatible with the residential nature of the neighborhood in which the Center is located;

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors does hereby set forth conditions for use of the Center as follows:

- 1. Use of the second and third floor space within the Center shall be limited to youth programs provided by community not-for-profit organizations for the purpose of conducting educational or recreational activities for youth such as meetings, training sessions, day camps, and other related activities.
- 2. Use of the second and third floor space within the Center shall not exceed a total of 100 hours per month.
- 3. The Santa Barbara County Parks Department will administer the Center's booking calendar providing the opportunity for advance reservation of space on a first come, first served basis in accordance with Department policy for all reservable park facilities.
