Recommendations:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve the Project, and accept the Categorical Exemption pursuant to the County's California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines for the Ballard Canyon Landfill Final Closure Third Supervisorial District; Solid Waste Project No. 828336; and,
- B. Authorize the Director of Public Works to advertise for construction bids for the Ballard Canyon Landfill Final Closure, Third Supervisorial District, Solid Waste Project No. 828336.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. V. Maintain and Enhance the Quality of Life for Residents.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

The proposed project is located north of the City of Solvang on Ballard Canyon Road. The proposed project consists of installing a final cover system, drainage improvements and erosion control over the former Ballard Canyon Landfill. The installation of the final cover system is a requirement of the California Regional Water Quality Board – Central Coast Region. The final cover system will prevent rainwater infiltration into the former landfill and subsequent leaching of contaminants into ground water. The project also includes drainage improvements to collect surface water runoff prior to it traveling onto the landfill, and channeling the surface water to a drainage course for discharge, and erosion control.
