That the Board of Supervisors adopt two resolutions establishing "Loading (Passenger)" zones on San Simeon Drive and Anita Lane in the unincorporated area of Goleta.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal #2: Ensure the public health and safety and provide essential infrastructure.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:

1. San Simeon Drive:

San Simeon Drive is a residential road that extends westward from San Marcos Road and is near El Camino Elementary School. The school is located on the north side of San Simeon Drive. A request was received from the school asking for a "Passenger Loading" zone to be placed on the north side of San Simeon Drive between the hours of 7:00a.m. and 3:30p.m. The reason for their request is that the school will no longer be releasing children at different times, but instead will let them go all at once, therefore the school needs more loading zones. Based upon our investigation of this site, it was determined that creating a "Passenger Loading" zone (see attached vicinity map), would create a safer environment for school children along San Simeon Drive. The Public Works Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolution to establish a "Passenger Loading" zone at the following location:

• On the north side of San Simeon Drive, from a point 360 feet east of the centerline of San Julio Avenue, to a point 575 feet east of the centerline of San Julio Avenue, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

2. Anita Lane:

Anita Lane is a residential road that extends eastward from Via El Cuadro and is near Hollister Elementary School, which is located on the north side of Anita Lane. A request was received from the school asking for a "Passenger Loading" zone to be placed on the north side of Anita Lane between 7:00a.m. and 3:30pm. The reason for their request is that the school will no longer be releasing children at different times, but instead will let them go all at once, therefore the school needs more loading zones. Based upon our investigation of this site, it was determined that creating a "Passenger Loading" zone at this location (see vicinity map), would create a safer environment for school children along San Simeon Drive. The Public Works Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolution to establish a "Passenger Loading" zone at the following location:

• On the north side of Anita Lane from a point 300 feet west of the centerline of Inwood Drive to a point 540 feet west of the centerline of Inwood Drive, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
