SUBJECT: Ordinance Amendment for Planning Commission Compensation

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Set a hearing for July 25, 2006 to consider revising compensation for the County Planning Commission as follows:

- A. Find that this project is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15378(b)(5) of the Guidelines for Implementation of CEQA;
- B. Consider the first reading (introduction) of an ordinance (Case No. 06ORD-00000-00011) amending the text of Section 2 of Chapter 2 of the Santa Barbara County Code revising compensation and reimbursement for the County Planning Commission;
- C. Set the second reading of the ordinance (Case No. 06ORD-00000-00011) for August 8, 2006.

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:

The recommendations are primarily aligned with Goal No. 1: An Efficient Government Able to Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community, and Goal No. 6: A County Government that is Accessible, Open and Citizen Friendly, and is required by law or routine business necessity.

Executive Summary and Discussion:

On May 16, 2006 your Board received a report to consider changes to Planning Commission compensation. Action regarding changing the compensation and mileage reimbursement was deferred to budget hearings. At the hearing of June 16, 2006, your Board approved a budget expansion to increase Planning Commissioner compensation by fifty dollars for each regular or special meeting, and to compensate Commissioners in the amount of fifty dollars for each Planning Commission subcommittee meeting attended. The budget expansion also provided for mileage reimbursement for all Commission related work. Reimbursement for mileage will be effective July 1, 2006, and the other increases will be effective January 1, 2007.

Compensation for the Planning Commission is authorized as part of the County Code and therefore requires an amendment to the Code to make changes. Attachment A is an amendment to Chapter 2, Article V of the County Code reflecting changes described above.

Mandates and Service Levels:

None

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The estimated cost of these changes is \$18,000 per year. These funds are included in the Commission/Board Support program on page D-286 of the 2006-07 adopted budget.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE V OF CHAPTER II OF THE SANTA BARBARA COUNTY CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 2-26.3 TO INCREASE COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EACH MEMBER OF THE PLANNING COMMISSIONER.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara ordains as follows:

SECTION 1:

Section 2-26.3, Compensation; Reimbursement for Mileage.

(a) The appointive members of the County Planning Commission shall receive as compensation for attendance at meetings of such commission the sum of two hundred and fifty three hundred dollars for each meeting attended, whether regular or special, as compensation. Members shall receive additional compensation in the amount of fifty dollars per meeting for review of materials and preparation. Additionally, members will be compensated fifty dollars for attendance of each meeting designated as a sub-committee of the County Planning Commission. Members shall be reimbursed by the County of Santa Barbara for their round-trip mileage from their places of business within this county to the place of the meeting of the planning commission at the rate per mile allowed to county officers and employees. Round-trip mileage for site visits shall be reimbursed at the rate per mile allowed to county officers and employees.

SECTION 2:

Except as amended by this Ordinance, Article V of Chapter 2, Administration, of the Code of the County of Santa Barbara, California, shall remain unchanged and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, it, or a summary of it, shall be published

once, together with the names of the members of the Board of Supervisors voting for and against the same in the Santa Barbara News-Press, a newspaper of general circulation published in the County of Santa Barbara.

SECTION 1:

Section 2-26.3, Compensation; Reimbursement for Mileage.

(a) The appointive members of the County Planning Commission shall receive as compensation for attendance at meetings of such commission the sum of three hundred dollars for each meeting attended, whether regular or special, as compensation. Members shall receive additional compensation in the amount of fifty dollars per meeting for review of materials and preparation. Additionally, members will be compensated fifty dollars for attendance of each meeting designated as a sub-committee of the County Planning Commission. Members shall be reimbursed by the County of Santa Barbara for their round-trip mileage from their places of business within this county to the place of the meeting of the planning commission at the rate per mile allowed to county officers and employees. Round-trip mileage for site visits shall be reimbursed at the rate per mile allowed to county officers and employees.

SECTION 2:

Except as amended by this Ordinance, Article V of Chapter 2, Administration, of the Code of the County of Santa Barbara, California, shall remain unchanged and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days from its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage, it, or a summary of it, shall be published
