SUBJECT: Legal Document Specialist Training Positions

Recommendation(s):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Adopt one resolution effective August 16, 2004 as follows:

CLERK-RECORDER-ASSESSOR (#0440)

Add: 2 (2.0 FTE) unfunded Legal Document Specialist I/II/III, (Classes 004651, 004652, 004653), Ranges 4536, 4666, 4826, (\$2,330 – \$2,845, \$2,486 – \$3,035, \$2,693 – \$3,288/month).

Alignment with Board Strategic Plan: An Efficient Government Able to Anticipate and Respond Effectively to the Needs of the Community and a Strong Professionally Managed County Organization

Executive Summary and Discussion: Over the last year we have had a significant increase in Workers Compensation Claims in our Clerk-Recorder functional area resulting in lost work time. While corrective actions have been taken to reduce these injuries, we expect a period of a year or two before all of the impacts are overcome and personnel fully recovered. This coupled with several medical leaves of absence and normal turnover has required using an abnormally high number of extra/temp help. This has required extensive training by our more experienced personnel and our supervisors, pulling these valuable resources away from serving customers and providing timely services. We currently have 36 Legal Document Specialist positions. We are requesting two (2) additional Legal Document Specialist I/II/III positions (unfunded) for up to two (2) years in order to reduce the use of extra help/temp agency personnel, which doesn't provide the quality level of services that is our expected standard.

Mandates and Service Levels: This will enhance service levels by providing greater stability and consistency.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts: The cost for these two positions will be about \$50,000 for FY 04-05 and \$56,000 for FY 05-06 if filled the entire time. The cost for these positions will be funded through savings in extra help/temp agency cost and salary savings from turnover. There are no facilities impacts associated with this request.
