RESOLUTION HONORING J'AMY BROWN FOR HER YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE TO THE CITIZENS OF SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, J'Amy Brown has lived in Montecito for eleven years, during which time she has performed countless hours of volunteering, been generous in her philanthropy and a strong advocate for a number of community organizations and efforts; and

WHEREAS, J'Amy is actively involved in maintaining the unique character of Montecito as demonstrated through her service on the Montecito Association Board of Directors for six years, including two years as president and six years on its land use committee which resulted in many significant accomplishments for the Montecito community during her tenure; and

WHEREAS, J'Amy has also promoted the importance of higher education through her role as a teacher, a Board member of the Foundation for Santa Barbara City College, as past president of Santa Barbara City College CARE Advisory Committee and as president of the Santa Barbara City College Adult Education Advisory Committee where she initiated a fund drive that contacted 40,000 students in 800 classes and raised \$250,000 during the 2003 budget crunch; and

WHEREAS, J'Amy's broad volunteerism has led to her continued involvement with Women's Economic Ventures, Newcomers Club, the Council on Self-Esteem, Santa Barbara Visual Arts, Heal the Ocean, the Chamber of Commerce Media Committee, the past Marketing Chair of the Goleta Valley Art Association and the Santa Barbara Zoo Development Committee and Zoofari Ball Committee; and

WHEREAS, J'Amy has been instrumental in keeping the public well informed and civically engaged by using her journalism background to write columns for the Santa Barbara News Press, the Montecito Journal and the newly created Montecito Montage on-line column for the Santa Barbara Independent.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors honors J'Amy Brown for her years of dedicated service to the citizens of Santa Barbara County and further commends her for her tireless efforts to improve the quality of life for all residents in our community.
