Chair Hart and Supervisors,

Once again, the Tepusquet Canyon Crisis Committee wants to urge you to adopt the Planning Commission's recommendation to require Conditional Use Permits (CUP's) for all cannabis operations. Additionally, we encourage you to apply the LUDC CUP amendment to all current applications, as well as permits that were previously issued permits but have not been vested.

The goal of making this change is to correct the issues that have arisen from the original ordinance. Thus, it should be applied broadly (instead of 'using a scalpel'), to avoid further problems. The number of times the cannabis projects are heard by the Planning Commission, appealed to the Board, etc., result in more costs to not only the growers but to our county, as well.

Re Future Hearing EDRN's: We would also like to see an agenda come before the PC and BOS to amend ordinances to prohibit commercial cannabis is EDRN's, as soon as possible.
