That the Board of Supervisors:

Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the Contractor, Union Asphalt, Inc. (a local vendor), Post Office Box 1280, Santa Maria, California 93456-1280, in the amount of \$397,786.41.

Summary Text:

This project, located in the unincorporated area west of the City of Lompoc, resurfaced two (2) lane miles of Floradale Avenue from Ocean Avenue to 1.0 mile north of Ocean Avenue. The construction consisted of repairing failed pavement areas, the placement of a Type B asphalt concrete overlay over a Stress Absorbing Membrane Interlayer (SAMI) and the application of an asphalt concrete leveling course. A separate, but concurrent, project upgraded and repaired the railroad crossing on Floradale Avenue. The upgrade and the repairs to the railroad crossing was a joint venture between the Union Pacific Railroad Company and the County of Santa Barbara wherein the County was responsible for 50% of the overall rail road repairs cost.

The Director of Public Works accepted this project as complete on December 6, 2006. The project was completed on time and on budget.

Background:

The specific project location was approved by your Board in FY 2006/07 Road Maintenance Annual Plan (RdMap) on March 28 , 2006 and is part of the 2004 State Transportation Improvement Program Roadway Rehabilitation Project for which the County received partial funding in Fiscal Year 2005/06.

Your Board also approved the project and CEQA Notice of Exemption on December 6, 2005 and the Reimbursement Agreement with Union Pacific Railroad for the upgrade and repair project was approved on August 1, 2006.

Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:

The total project funding, including contingency allocations, was provided by Federal Funds from the Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP). These funds were budgeted in Dept. 054, Fund 0015, Program 2900, Org 0001, and Account 7510.
