A. Approve the attached <u>Notice of Exemption</u> pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines re: vacating the County's right-of-way easement to a portion of Stillwell Road on Santa Barbara County Assessor's Parcel No. 103-200-069 near Santa Maria; and

B. Adopt the attached Resolution, <u>Summary Order to Vacate</u>, vacating the above referenced portion of Stillwell Road, Fourth District (4/5 vote required).

#### **Executive Summary and Discussion:**

The area of the proposed vacation is shown on "Exhibit A" attached to the Summary Order to Vacate and shall be referred to herein as the "Portion." The fee owner of the Portion requested the County's right-of-way easement be removed and vacated. The Portion was never developed or used as a public right-of-way. Transportation has no objection to the proposed vacation of the Portion.
