RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING APRIL 23rd THROUGH APRIL 29th 2006, AS VICTIMS' RIGHTS WEEK

WHEREAS, crime and fear of crime continue to be serious problems for the citizens of California; and

WHEREAS, the criminal justice system would fail to function without the cooperation of victims and witnesses; and

WHEREAS, a fair and balanced criminal justice system must ensure that the needs and rights of victims are not overlooked in the process of protecting the rights of the accused; and

WHEREAS, California has established Victim Witness Assistance centers throughout the State to assist victims and to reduce their trauma; and

WHEREAS, victims and witnesses who have suffered loss and trauma deserve fair and sensitive treatment by representatives of the criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the observance of Victims' Rights Week provides an opportunity to inform the public of the problems, needs, and rights of victims and witnesses, and of the range of services and assistance available, and to acknowledge the efforts of concerned citizens, law makers and the criminal justice system to provide and continue to improve those services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that April 23rd through April 29th, 2006 be proclaimed Victims' Rights Week.
