- B. Review and approve the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed and materials supplied for this project by the contractor R. Burke Corporation, for the total amount of \$322,780.74.

Summary Text:

The Board approved the award of the contract for the Tajiguas Landfill Out-of-Channel Basin Improvements on July 22, 2010. The project was accepted as complete on January 18, 2011.

Background:

In 2009, the Board of Supervisors certified the Subsequent EIR and Resource Recovery and Waste Management Division (RRWMD) received all permits and regulatory approvals to reconfigure the 2003 Tajiguas Landfill Expansion Project. This reconfiguration provides a significant cost reduction due to a decrease in earthmoving activities. It also provides environmental benefits that include preserving and improving the out-of-channel sedimentation basin. At the time of the certification of the Subsequent EIR

and the Board's approval of the project, the Board authorized RRWMD to advertise/solicit for bids for construction of project elements. This contract involved the construction of the out-of-channel sedimentation basin improvements which is one design element of the approved and permitted Tajiguas Landfill Reconfiguration Project.
