

## RESOLUTION NO. 12-41

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2012 WITH THE STATEWIDE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THAT DATE PURSUANT TO SECTION 10403 OF THE ELECTIONS CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Goleta called a General Municipal Election to be held on November 6, 2012, for the purpose of the election of two members of the City Council for four-year full terms; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council is submitting to the voters the Question Relating to Goleta Transient Occupancy Tax Measure and Goleta Agricultural Land Protection Initiative

**WHEREAS**, it is desirable that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Election to be held on the same date and that within the City the precincts, polling places and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the County Election Department of the County of Santa Barbara canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLETA DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

### **SECTION 1.**

That pursuant to the requirements of Section 10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 6, 2012, for the purpose of the election of two Members of the City Council for four-year full terms.

### **SECTION 2.**

That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Goleta, California, on Tuesday, November 6, 2012, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of Submitting to the Voters the adoption of Ordinance No.12-07 increasing the rate of the City's Transient Occupancy Tax to twelve percent

**SECTION 3.**

That a measure is to appear on the ballot as follows:

<b>Goleta Transient Occupancy Tax Measure.</b> In order to provide additional funding to enhance city services such as public safety, road maintenance, revitalization efforts in Old Town, and provide support for other fundamental City services, shall an ordinance be adopted increasing the Transient Occupancy Tax ("Bed Tax") charged to hotel guests staying in Goleta from 10% to 12%, with the proceeds placed in the City's General Fund? **SECTION 4.**

That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Goleta, California, on Tuesday, November 6, 2012, a General Municipal Election for the purpose of Submitting to the Voters the Goleta Agricultural Protection Initiative

**SECTION 5.**

That a measure is to appear on the ballot as follows:

<b>Goleta Agricultural Land Protection Initiative.</b> Should the City of Goleta General Plan be amended to require that for the next twenty years any changes to specified policies and designation of certain land 10 acres or more currently designated as Agriculture be required to be approved by the voters as well as the City Council, subject to certain limited exceptions?	Yes

**SECTION 6.**

That the County Election Division is authorized to canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

**SECTION 7.**

That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County Election Division to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

**SECTION 8.**

That the City of Goleta recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for such costs.


**SECTION 9.**

That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the County Election Division of the County of Santa Barbara.

**SECTION 10.**

That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
