

- 1896 First Offshore Oil Drilling via piers







Plugging & Abandonment Standards

- No established laws, regulations or standards for abandonment.
- Wells were just abandoned or capped improperly.
- Use of rock, logs, telephone poles and other debris.

- Community concern of increased seepage.
- Is increase from man-made or natural causes?
