Briefly describe your plan:

Based on the goals below, my plan is pure mathematics. I constructed an EXCEL spreadsheet, and crunched the numbers. The spreadsheet is attached. I established the variances to 84,779, and developed a logical sequence of movement from 5 to 4, 2 to 1, 3 to 2, 4 to 3.

The sequence was important to maintaining minimum movement of voters from one district to another. I made every reasonable effort to maintain historical context and coherent shapes and contours.

It was impossible to hit the numbers exactly due to the odd size and shape of the census blocks. I have been a Planner and Logistics Manager for 30 year in the private sector. My policy and experience is to keep it simple whenever possible.

Briefly describe the goals of your plan: (example: keep rural areas together, keep a city in a specific district, etc.)

The 2008 and 2010 Voters First redistricting initiatives passed by the voters laid out new rules and new criteria for redistricting at the state level. My attempt was to reflect, at the County level, the "spirit" of these initiatives approved by the Voters of California. Prop 27 in 2010 (to eliminate Citizens Redistricting Commission) failed by 63% NO TO 37% YES in Santa Barbara County. I hope we all got the message.

My goal was to logically move the minimum number of people. My focus was on the math, and I avoided political considerations. Though problematic in such a diverse population, I kept an eye to Communities of Interest, Contiguity, Compactness, Geography, and Historical Context.

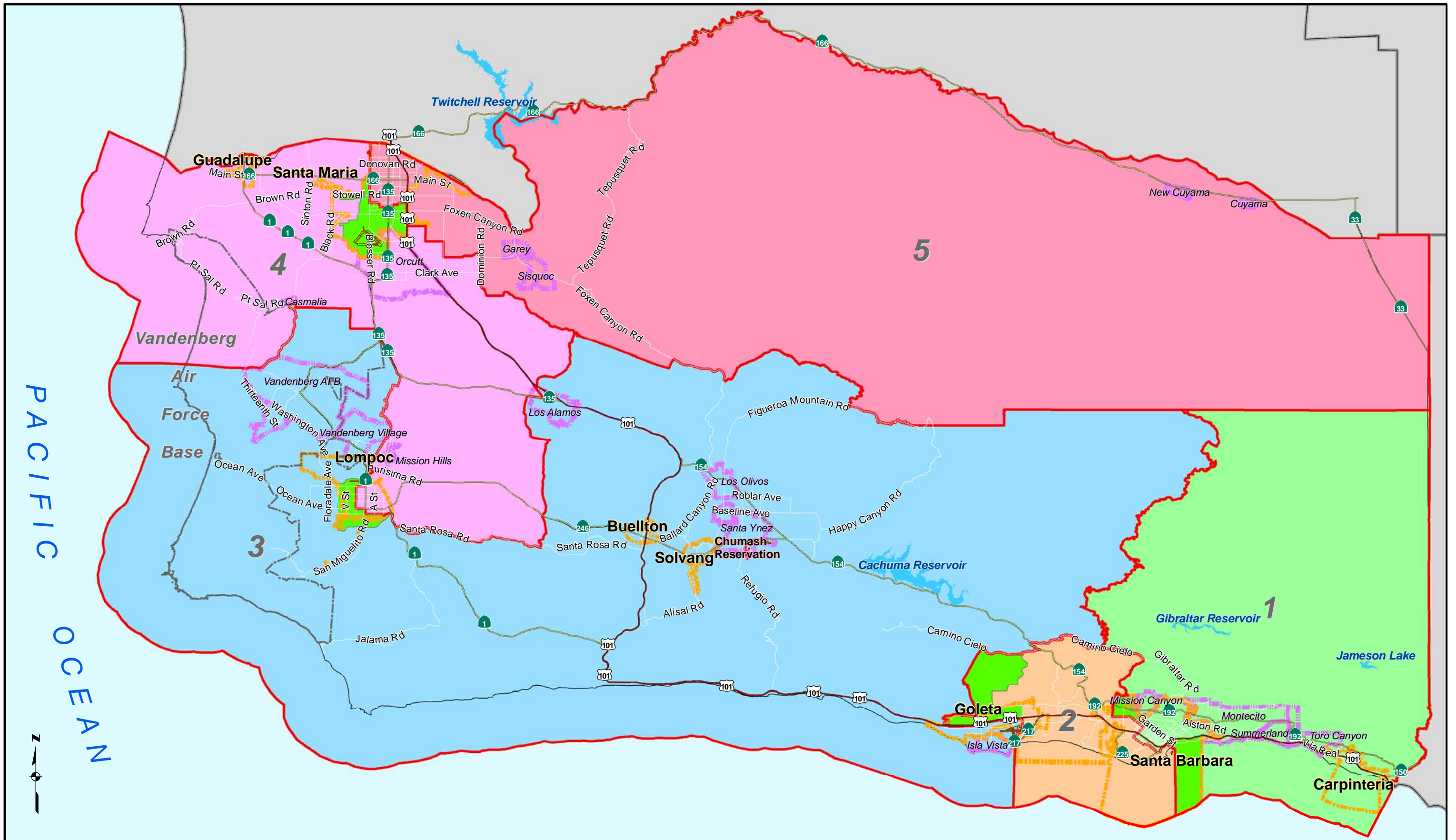
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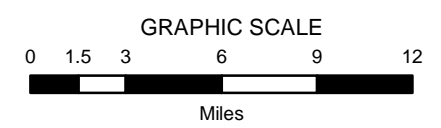
