



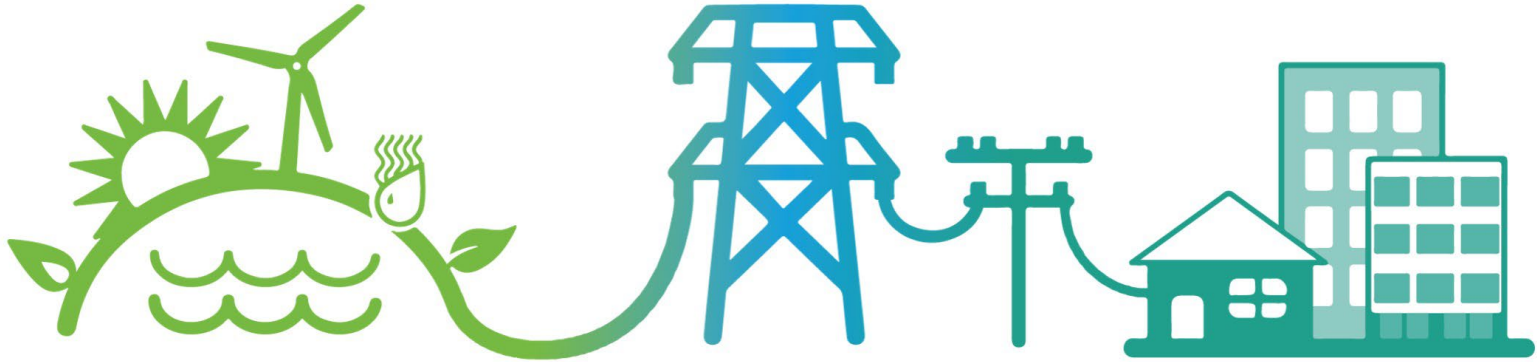

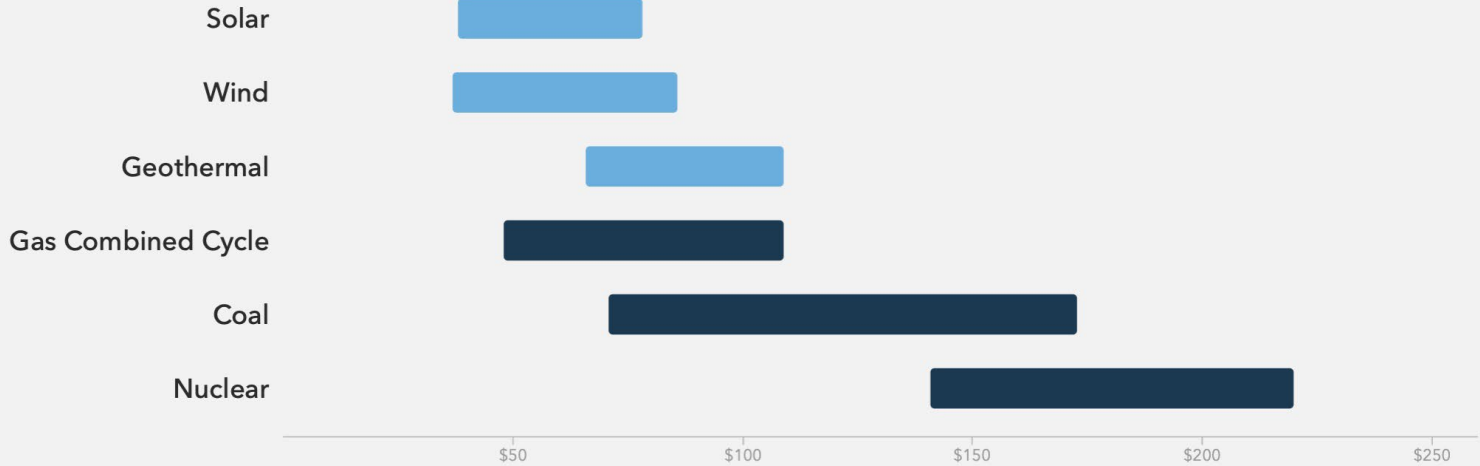

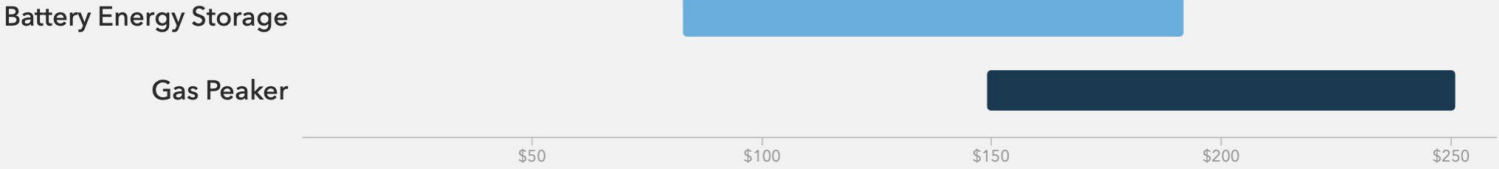


Cost to Build New Energy Resources (Nationwide Average)

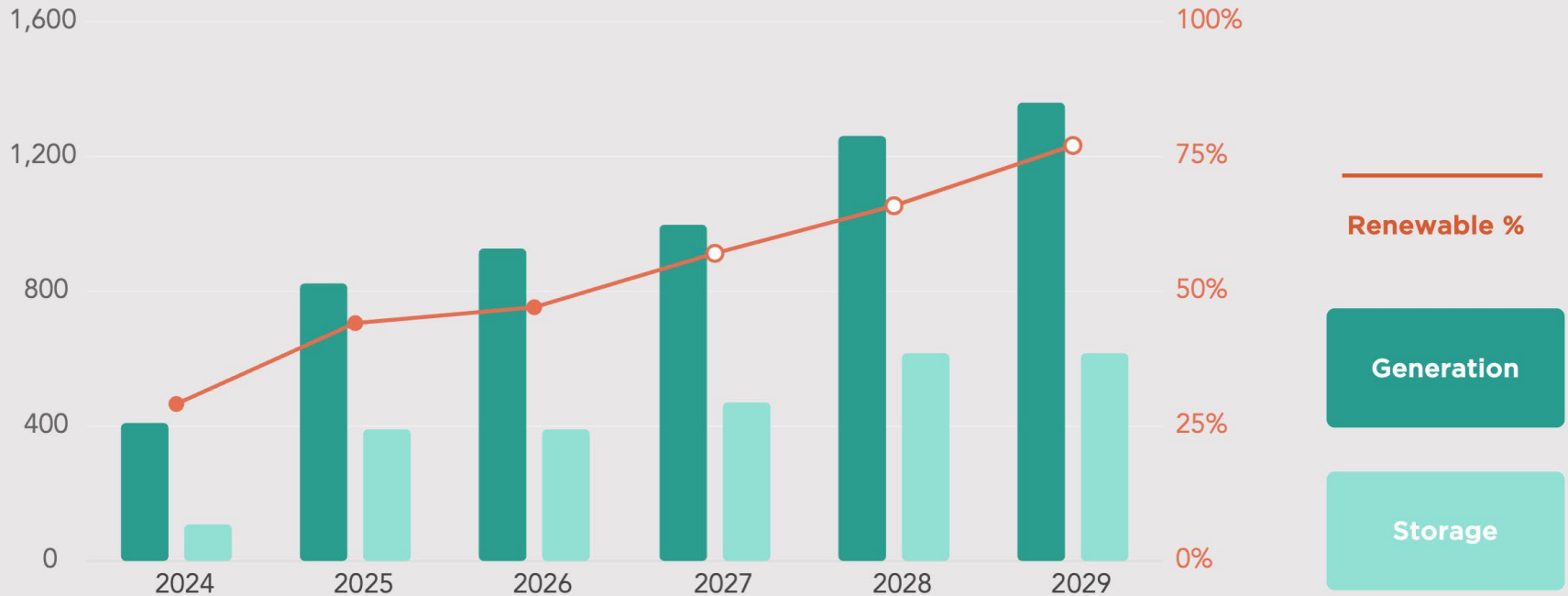

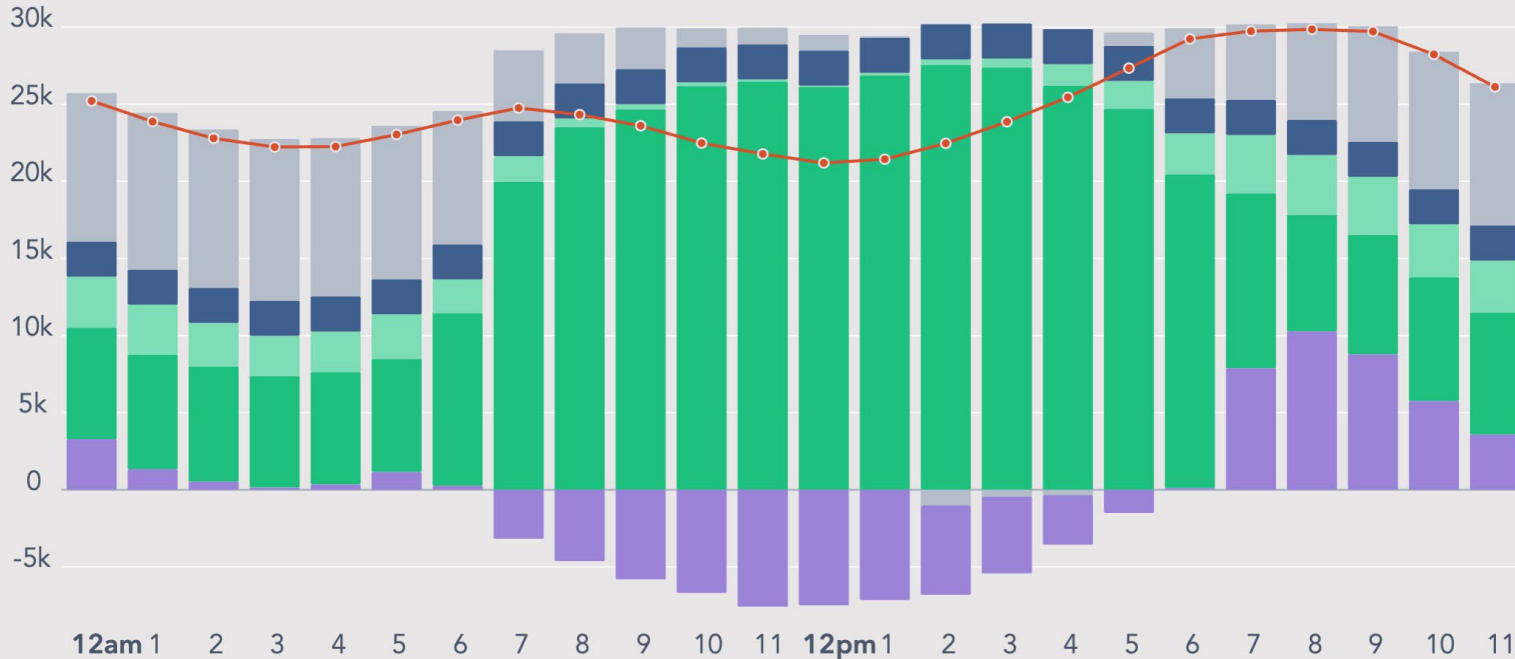
