RECOMMENDATION

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution establishing an angle parking zone on Pacific Street in the Orcutt Area.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal #2: Ensure the public health and safety and provide essential infrastructure and Goal #5: Maintain and enhance the quality of life for all residents.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AND DISCUSSION

In February, a request was received to paint angle parking stalls on the west side of Pacific Street north of Union Avenue. Vehicles have historically been angle parking on Pacific Street in front of the business located on the northwest corner of Union Avenue and Pacific Street. There was some confusion on enforcement in this area recently, and the Department would like to clear that up with the proper resolution. Based on this history and field studies, it was determined that angle parking would be appropriate at this location which complies with the Old Town design guidelines. The Public Works Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolution to establish an angle parking zone at the following location:

- On the west side of Pacific Street from the centerline of Union Avenue to a point 132 feet north of the centerline of Union Avenue.



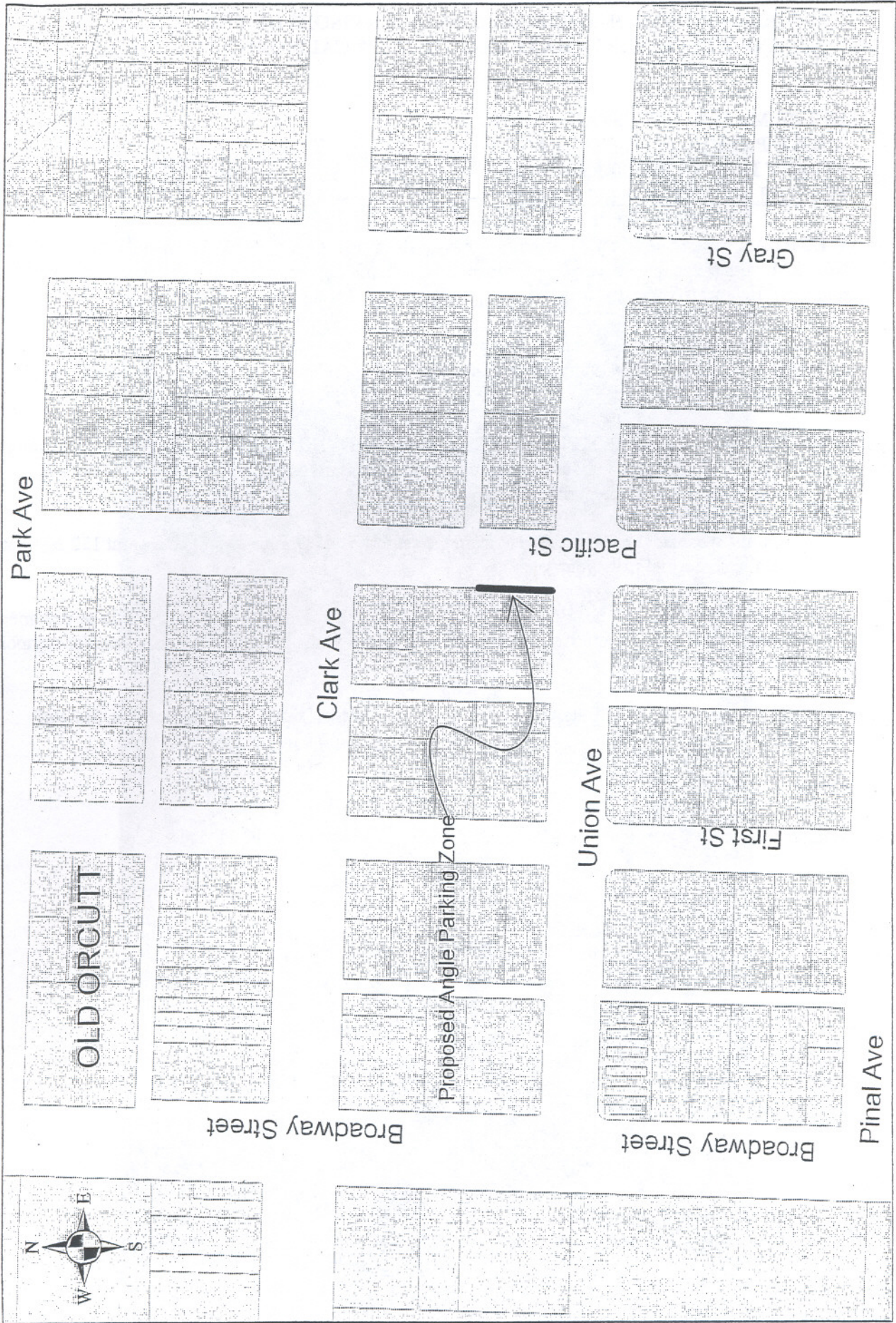
