Recommended Action(s):

That the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached resolution allowing the use of agricultural truck and two-trailer combinations of up to 75 feet in length for certain local trips when hauling produce within Santa Barbara County, as allowed by recently passed Senate Bill 1237.

Summary:

The Governor recently signed SB 1237 into law. The bill authorizes the use of truck and two-trailer vehicle combinations with a maximum length of 75 feet (as opposed to the 65-foot restriction otherwise) to continue to operate hauling produce within Santa Barbara County. The attached resolution provides additional details of SB 1237 for your review.

To enable the new provisions, which will become effective January 1, 2007, the County is required to adopt, by resolution, California Vehicle Code Section 35401, Subparagraph (b) as amended by the Senate Bill.

Also attached is a route map showing the rural roads to be used connecting vegetable fields and processing facilities. Public Works staff has reviewed the routes and has determined that no additional negative impacts to the county road system will occur. The California Highway Patrol Commercial Vehicles Division has also been consulted.
