### A. PRICE RANCH ROAD (one directional) – Third Supervisorial District

Adopt a resolution establishing a stop control on Price Ranch Road at its intersection with El Camino Real in the Los Alamos area.

## B. MANZANA STREET (2-way stop) – Third Supervisorial District

Adopt a resolution establishing stop controls on Manzana Street at its intersection with Faraday Street in the Santa Ynez area.

#### **Summary Text:**

Several requests were received from citizens in the Santa Ynez and the Los Alamos areas. These requests were based on perception of safety issues and included concerns regarding sight distance and knowing who needs to stop and/or yield right-of-way.

Based upon our investigation, the Public Works Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolutions (two) establishing stop controls at the following locations:

## **Background:**

Stop controls are established based on safety and sight distance restrictions, necessity and how it relates to the use by the community as a whole. All of these factors are weighed by the Traffic Section and any changes recommended are presented to the Board of Supervisors for approval.

#### Price Ranch Road:

The request for a 1-way stop control at this intersection was iniated by residents in the Los Alamos area due to safety concerns and sight distance restrictions at this intersection.

### Manzana Street:

The request for 2-way stop controls was iniated by a resident in the Santa Ynez area to address safety concerns at this intersection.
