IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND ADMINISTRATION OF EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANTS PROGRAM FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA BY THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA

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A necessary quorum and majority of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara ("State ESG Administrative Entity") hereby consent to, adopt and ratify the following resolutions:

- A. WHEREAS the State of California (the "State"), Department of Housing and Community Development ("Department") issued a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Continuum of Care Allocation dated June 6, 2017 under the 2017 Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program ("Program"); and
- B. WHEREAS County of Santa Barbara is an approved ESG Administrative Entity; and
- C. WHEREAS the Department may approve funding allocations for the ESG Program, subject to the terms and conditions of the NOFA, program guidelines and requirements, and the Standard Agreement and other contracts between Department and ESG grant recipients;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. If <u>County of Santa Barbara</u> receives a grant of funds from the Department pursuant to a Department NOFA, it represents and certifies that it will use all such funds in a manner consistent and in compliance with all applicable state, federal, and other statutes, rules, regulations, guidelines and laws ("rules and laws"), including without limitation all rules and laws regarding the ESG Program, as well as any and all contracts <u>County of Santa Barbara</u> may have with Department.
- 2. <u>County of Santa Barbara</u> is hereby authorized and directed to receive an ESG grant in 2017 in an amount not to exceed \$583,706, in accordance with all rules and laws.
- 3. <u>County of Santa Barbara</u> is hereby authorized and directed to receive an ESG grant in 2018, in an amount not to exceed 120% or be below 80% of \$583,706 in accordance with all rules and laws.
- 4. <u>County of Santa Barbara</u> hereby agrees to use the ESG funds for eligible activities as approved by the Department and in accordance with all Program requirements, and other rules and laws, as well as in a manner consistent and in compliance with the Standard Agreement and other contracts between State ESG Administrative Entity and Department.

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5. Mona Miyasato, County Executive Officer, or designee(s), are authorized to execute the Standard Agreement and any subsequent amendments or modifications thereto, as well as any other documents which are related to the Program or the ESG grant awarded to State ESG Administrative Entity in years 2017 and 2018, as the Department may deem appropriate.
