**Summary Text:** Women's History Month is an annual nationally declared month that highlights contributions of women to events in history. Women's History Month encourages all Americans to reflect on the ways in which women have shaped U.S. History.

**Background:** The public celebration of women's history in this country began in 1978 as "Women's History Week" in Sonoma County, California. In1981, Sen. Orrin Hatch (R-Utah) and Rep. Barbara Mikulski (D-Md.) co-sponsored a joint Congressional resolution proclaiming a national Women's History Week. In 1987, Congress expanded the celebration to a month, and March was declared Women's History Month.
