

# **Animal Waste Management Plan**

For Horse Stables and Related Facilities located at  
120 Meadowlark Road, Santa Ynez, CA 93460  
*Effective 02/01/2016*

In order to contain animal waste, control odor and vectors, protect environmental resources, and maintain clean conditions for the horse stables, pens and related facilities located at 120 Meadowlark Road, the owners (Greg and Robin Brous) presently implement and proposes to maintain the following Animal Waste Management Plan ("AWMP") designed to comply with the California Code of Regulations Title 14, Chapter 3, Article 8, *Agricultural Solid Waste Standards*.

The plan involves collecting the horse waste on a routine basis, depositing the horse waste into on-site enclosed waste container/s, and contracting for the transportation of the collected waste on a routine basis, to an approved solid waste handling facility. As of the effective date of this AWMP, the waste disposal company Waste Management ("WM") has been contracted to provide an empty waste container for the collection of the horse waste, and to transport that horse waste off the property on a routine basis.

The Animal Waste Management Plan includes the following measures:

- 1) At least once per day, manure and soiled bedding is being collected from working stalls.
- 2) Collected manure and soiled bedding is being stored temporarily in watertight trash bins and emptied into larger receptacles in a designated trash area. Manure is being transported on as needed basis to an approved solid waste site.
- 3) General sanitation is being maintained with good air circulation and exposure to sunlight in animal confinement areas. In order to maintain odor and vector control, the receptacles are being unloaded at a minimum, once per week to an approved solid waste container for removal.
- 4) An automatic fly system has been installed to control fly and other insect populations.
- 5) Equipment used is a tractor, UTV, hand tools including rake, pitchfork, drag and shovels.
- 6) Meadows in use shall be cleaned, raked, dragged once a week.
- 7) An Animal Waste container/trailer has been purchased/leased from the waste management service and kept on site.
