5G Free Santa Barbara requests this letter be read into the record, March 24, 2020.

We understand that the COVID-19 pandemic creates difficult decisions for all.

5G Free Santa Barbara has been meeting with public officials and working with city attorney on a draft protective ordinance regarding small and large wireless facilities, which include cell antennas and cell towers. Recently, the city council voted for a 90 day pause on approval of a Verizon deregulation ordinance allowing installation of cell antennas on city street lights.

Over 25,000 peer reviewed studies show biological harm and impaired immunity caused by Radio Frequency Micro Wave Radiation from 2,3, and 4G.

Children and people with weakened immune systems are especially vulnerable to Radio Frequency Micro Wave Radiation.

On March 19th, Governor Newsom announced his intention to expand the deployment of wireless infrastructure in schools during the COVID-19 quarantine.

Dear SB County Board of Supervisors,

I request that my comments be read into the public record.

As a member of 5G Free Santa Barbara I am requesting transparency and clarity regarding the potential installation of small and large cell facilities on our school campuses during this interim of school closure. On March 19th, Governor Newsom announced his intention to expand the deployment of wireless infrastructure in schools, during the COVID-19 quarantine. On my afternoon walk, I stopped by Santa Barbara High School. During my brief visit, I observed a large white truck entering the campus driven by a non-English speaking driver. It had the words "Insulate" written on it. The driver was unable to inform me what he was transporting to campus.

2G, 3G and 4G small cell and large cell antennas have incurred well documented biological harms to our fireman demonstrated by Brain Spec Scans of fireman who worked in proximity to small cell and large cell facilities. At a time when our immune systems and nervous systems are most vulnerable due to our current worldwide pandemic, please assure 5G Free SB that our campuses will not be subject to increased densification of radio frequency radiation when our students return to campus.
