#### **Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve and authorize the Chair to adopt the attached Resolution establishing road maintenance charges (with no increase in benefit assessment) for County Service Area #41.
- B. Find that the proposed action is not subject to CEQA and approve filing the attached Notice of Exemption pursuant to 152373 (a) (1) and 14 CCR.

#### **Summary Text:**

Funding for County Service Area #41 is from benefit assessments. A benefit assessment is a levy or charge by an agency upon real property that is based upon the special benefit conferred upon the real property by an improvement or service that is imposed to pay the capital cost of the improvement, the maintenance and operation expenses of the improvement, or the cost of the service being provided. The Board must annually adopt the benefit assessment rates in order to assess them on the tax roll.

The average assessment of \$465 is proposed to be maintained for FY 2011-12. The proposed assessments will generate approximately \$23,704 in revenues.

Pursuant to the County's CEQA guideline 15273 (a) (1), the Department of Public Works has determined this project to be exempt from further environmental review. Approval of this Notice of Exemption shall indicate the Board of Supervisors' approval of this project and will commence the appeal period, pursuant to CEQA guidelines.
