*WHEREAS, those with disabilities should have the same opportunities for education and recreation as their non-disabled peers and also should be treated with dignity and respect; and*

*WHEREAS, The Rhythmic Arts Project (TRAP) based in Carpinteria offers a program that promotes inclusion and increased social interaction opportunities and helps participants learn basic life skills through the motivational tool of drumming; and*

*WHEREAS, the annual fundraising benefit for TRAP will be held on June 3 at Girls Inc. in Carpinteria where families, friends and supporters will be entertained by an impressive and world-famous array of Latin, Jazz, Gospel and Rock musicians who will gather to perform for more than 500 music lovers; and*

*WHEREAS, The Rhythmic Arts Project has expanded to more than nine states with the goal of beginning a program in Europe this year;*

*NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors proclaims June 3-9, 2007 as "The Rhythmic Arts Project" Week in Santa Barbara County and encourages residents to participate in the benefit concert supporting those challenged by disabilities in our community.*
