That the Board of Supervisors:

Execute the attached Agreement(s) to provide Emergency Dispatching Services between the County of Santa Barbara and the Carpinteria Summerland Fire Protection District These contracts shall begin July 1, 2006 and will continue through June 30, 2011, unless earlier terminated.

Summary Text:

The County of Santa Barbara, through the Sheriff's Department, has agreed to provide Emergency Dispatching Services within the limits of the Carpinteria Summerland Fire Protection District. These services shall provide 24-hour, seven days a week, fire and paramedic rescue emergency dispatching; plus, direct support and administrative functions.

Background:

In keeping with current law, County policy, and practice, this contract provides for "full cost recovery" for services rendered, and realizes no increase in net county costs. With approval of this contract, appropriate entries reflecting the inclusion of this contract will continue to be included within the Sheriff's Department submitted proposed budgets during the duration of the contract.

These contracts will generate approximately \$80,000-90,000 per year to the Sheriff's Department depending on the call volume for the fire district. This revenue offsets costs incurred in providing the dispatch services. The revenue and expense are included in the FY2006-07 Adopted Budget.
