It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors for the County of Santa Barbara:

- a) Set hearing for the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Recommended Operating Plan and Budget for the County of Santa Barbara to begin Monday, June 12, 2017 and continue if necessary, through Friday, June 23, 2017, with specific hearings scheduled for Monday, June 12th, and if necessary, Wednesday, June 14th, and Friday, June 16th, 2017; and

Summary Text:

Budget hearings for both the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Recommended Operating Plan and Budget for Santa Barbara County; and the Recommended Budget for Santa Barbara County as Successor Agency to the former County of Santa Barbara Redevelopment Agency are scheduled for the week of June 12-16, 2017, and if necessary, may be continued into the week of June 19-23, 2017.

Background:

Budget Hearings are scheduled to begin at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, June 12, 2017. The County Executive Office will begin with a presentation highlighting the major issues and funding allocations in the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Recommended Budget, and any significant changes made since the April Budget Workshops. Board discussions, deliberation and adoption of the budget are scheduled for Monday, June 12th, and if necessary Wednesday, June 14th, and Friday, June 16th, 2017. In line with past practice, Budget Hearings will also be noticed for the week of June 19-23, 2017, in the event additional time is needed.

The Recommended Budgets for the County of Santa Barbara and for the County of Santa Barbara as Successor Agency to the former County of Santa Barbara Redevelopment Agency will be posted on the County's website at http://www.countyofsb.org/default.aspx by Friday, May 26, 2017 and will be available in hard copy starting May 25, 2017 for public review at the Clerk of the Board office, 105 East Anapamu Street, Room 407, Santa Barbara, California, between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., weekdays and at the public libraries during their posted operating hours. Budget hearings and availability of the Recommended Budgets will be noticed (Attachment A) no later than Friday, May 26, 2017 in the Santa Barbara News-Press, Lompoc Record, Santa Ynez Valley News, and the Santa Maria Times.

Ongoing Contracts and Grants

In order to efficiently manage the Board's agenda, a list of on-going grants and contracts, by department, will be presented at budget hearings with a recommendation that the Board approve, as a group, their renewal for FY 2017-18. This process is only for single year contracts, not multi-year agreements. To qualify for this process:

- 1. all contract terms and conditions, including contract scope of work, must remain unchanged from the prior contract, and
- 2. the value of the contract cannot change by more than 10% of the prior year

Ongoing contracts or grants in amounts that exceed 10% must be individually presented to the Board for approval. If rates or units of service change, the contract may qualify for the on-going contracts process if these changes are clearly disclosed on the ongoing contract list.
