

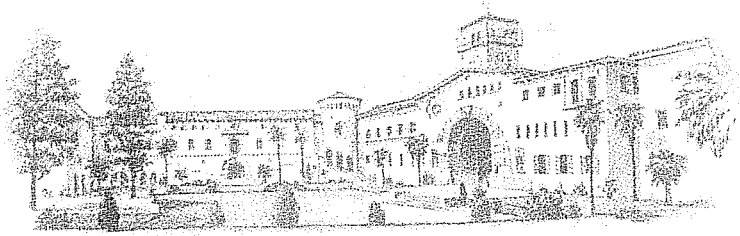

12-13. Experience & Additional Information:

I was born and raised in Santa Barbara and have intimately experienced the beauty and challenges that exist within our community. The tradition of community service has been bestowed upon me from my family members who have offered many years of service to the Santa Barbara community. As a result of their example, I have volunteered my time at organizations such as La Casa de la Raza and Girls, Inc. of Greater Santa Barbara. Also, working in the field of equal opportunity for 11 years and addressing matters of discrimination, harassment and retaliation, I am reminded daily of the importance of equitable access, fair treatment, diversity and each citizen's role in creating the necessary change for achieving such an environment. Through these experiences, I have realized the need that exists among the women and girls within our community and would like to participate in the response to such issues. The mission of the Commission for Women (CFW) embodies some of the principles I have striven to achieve through my professional, personal and volunteer experiences.

As a former staff member of various commissions including the Commission for Women, I have a clear understanding of the role and expectations of a county commissioner and the mission statement of the CFW. Through my years of service, I have formulated ideas as to how I can contribute to the action plan of the CFW and offer a different perspective to the group. In my current position at UCSB, I have the ability to work with and among a diversified population. As the Sexual Harassment Officer and Senior Equal Opportunity Investigator, I am primarily responsible for responding to matters of discrimination, harassment and retaliation among faculty, staff and students. Through my position, I am also able to participate in collaborative projects with the Women's Center, the Title IX Officer and the Multicultural Center. Additionally, I currently serve on the Chancellor's Advisory Committee on the Status of Women and the Intercollegiate Athletics Diversity Training Committee. This experience would immediately lend service to the work of the CFW and the exchange of information would behoove both the campus environment and the greater surrounding community.

As a new mother, societal issues have taken on a new meaning. As I look at my daughter, I feel a greater call to action to work toward societal and professional equity for women. The Santa Barbara community has transformed in many ways since the days of my childhood in terms of its response to global awareness, social justice issues and cultural recognition and sensitivity. I hope to offer the same amount of progress, if not more, to my daughter so that she may know a better community and continue the legacy of social activism.
