**Recommended Actions:**

That the Board of Directors:

- a) Approve and authorize the Chair to execute the Statement of Final Quantities for work performed for the Multipurpose Disposal Site Material Sorting Emergency Project (Project No. 23STM1-S51M) by the contractor Remedial Transportation Services, Inc. (not a local vendor) in the amount of \$234,569.00; and
- b) Determine that these emergency actions were found by the Board to be exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15269(c) – Emergency Projects. A Notice of Exemption was filed on this basis on January 24, 2023, and the proposed action is within the scope of that Notice of Exemption. **Summary Text:**

This item is on the agenda in order to obtain Board approval and authorization to execute the Statement of Final Quantities (SFQ) for the Multipurpose (MPS) Disposal Site Material Sorting Emergency Project. On August 22, 2023, the Board entered into an agreement with Remedial Transportation Services, Inc. to

perform the emergency stockpile material sorting. This agreement, by authority of the Board on August 22, 2023, was in the base contract amount of \$234,569.00. The project was completed at a cost of \$234,569.00.

The Flood Control District (District) has accepted the work of the contractor Remedial Transportation Services, Inc. completed per plans and specifications. On September 28, 2023, the Notice of Completion for this project was recorded by the Clerk Recorder’s Office.

**Background:**

The MPS is located near 4400 Cathedral Oaks Road in the unincorporated area of Santa Barbara County just west of Highway 154. The MPS has been used by the District for temporary storage and transfer of stockpiled materials.

On January 9, 2023, a storm (23STM1) severely impacted Santa Barbara County and a Federal Disaster (DR-4683-CA) was declared. The storm caused the deposit of sediment throughout the 18 debris basins located in the South County. District environmental staff developed criteria for initial sorting of suitable beach bound material for each worksite and trucking/hauling operations proceeded to transfer material to the beach sites. Of the remaining material, much of it was found suitable for stock piling at the MPS which was managed by the District.

The project goal was to screen and sort stockpile material into specified gradation piles. These piles can now be used for County Public Works projects.
