Recommended Actions:

That the Board of Supervisors:

- a) Approve and authorize a contribution of \$10,000 to 805UNDOCUFund, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, funded by the Second District’s Discretionary Funds held in Department 990 fund balance;
- b) Approve Budget Revision Request No. 0010962 to increase Appropriations of \$10,000 in the General County Programs General Fund for Services and Supplies, funded by a release of Committed Emerging Issues fund balance;
- c) Find that the above program provides a community benefit that meets the social needs of the population of the County; and
- d) Determine that the above actions are organizational or administrative activities of government that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment and are not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to section 15378(b)(5) of the CEQA Guidelines.

Summary Text:

In recent years, each Board of Supervisors District Office has been allocated discretionary funding to support projects and programs that address community needs and enhance the quality of life. These allocations require Board approval on the Administrative Agenda.

This action will authorize a \$10,000 contribution from the Second District Office to the 805UNDOCUFund to continue providing services to for short-term, in-kind, non-cash emergency disaster relief for undocumented communities in Santa Barbara County.

Discussion:

This recommendation is to approve and authorize a \$10,000 contribution from the Second District Office’s 990 funding allocation to the 805UNDOCUFund.

Background:

The 805UNDOCUFund was established in January 2018 in response to the Thomas Fire and Montecito Mudslides, disasters that displaced thousands of residents and caused widespread loss of housing, employment, and long-term health impacts. While state and federal disaster relief played a critical role in community recovery, undocumented residents—estimated to comprise approximately 10% of the population in Ventura and Santa Barbara Counties—were categorically excluded from millions of dollars in available assistance. The organization fills a critical gap by delivering emergency assistance, stabilization resources, and trusted community support.
