Dear Mr. Martin:

Please allow this correspondence to serve as formal written notice of Corizon Health, Inc.'s (Corizon Health's) offer to extend the term of the Correctional Medicine Agreement between Corizon Health and the County of Santa Barbara, California (County) for a two (2) year period (July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2017). Corizon Health's offer to extend consists of the following terms:

- Annual Base Compensation:
 - Extension Contract Year 1 (July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2016):
 - Cost for Sheriff Services: \$3,692,237, payable in 12 monthly installments of \$307,686.42.
 - Cost for Probation Services: \$821,418, payable in 12 monthly installments of \$68,451.50.
 - Extension Contract Year 2 (July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017):
 - Cost for Sheriff Services: \$3,788,974, payable in 12 monthly installments of \$315,747.83.
 - Cost for Probation Services: \$842,939, payable in 12 monthly installments of \$70,244.92.
- Notwithstanding the aforementioned items, the terms and conditions of the Agreement will continue unchanged and in full force and effect for the two (2) year extension period.
