WHEREAS, the goal of the California Avocado Festival is to conduct an annual festival for the enjoyment of the people of the State, the promotion of avocados, the funding of community projects and the development of tourism within the Carpinteria Valley; and

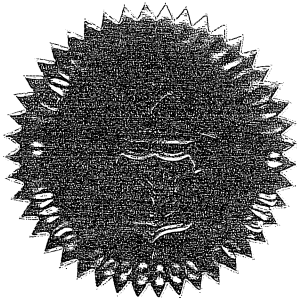

WHEREAS, the California Avocado Festival and its volunteer members have made numerous contributions to the community including helping many local non-profit clubs raise awareness of the services they provide, and assisting these groups with fundraising efforts to sustain and support their programs; and

WHEREAS, the California Avocado Festival has adopted practices to promote the importance of sustainability by implementing a recycling/diversion rate of 74%, demanding a "No Styrofoam Zone" and utilizing biodiesel generators;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors the California Avocado Festival members on their 30th anniversary and further commends them for their continuing dedication to community service.
