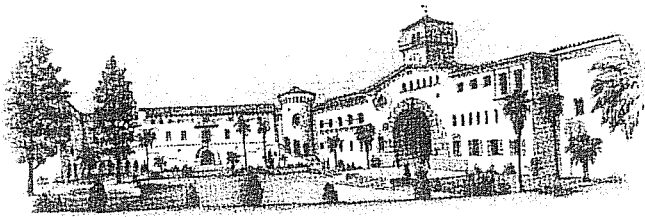

RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR HAROLD POWELL OF ADVANCED ENVIRONMENTS FOR AN ENERGY-EFFICIENT RESIDENTIAL BUILDING

WHEREAS, Advanced Environments designed and remodeled an existing residence at 2695 Foothill Road in Santa Barbara to meet Target 3 of the Innovative Building Review Program, the highest level of the program reserved for those projects that demonstrate an exceptionally high level of energy efficiency through innovative designs and technologies; and

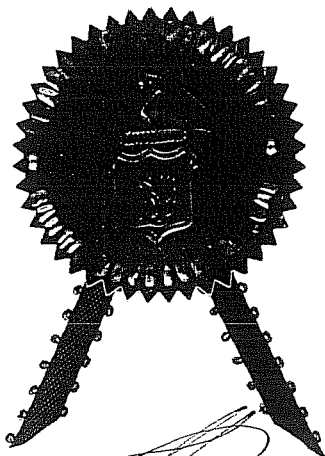
WHEREAS, Advanced Environments' residential building incorporates several energy-efficient techniques, such as passive solar heating design, photovoltaic system, solar water heating, blown-in insulation in walls and ceiling, formaldehyde-free particle board for cabinetry, and zero VOC paints; and

WHEREAS, Advanced Environments' residential building surpasses California's Energy-Efficient Standards by 41%, lowering the rate of energy consumption by approximately 12,000 kWh's per year and reducing the building's energy bills by approximately \$1,700 per year; and

WHEREAS, the County's Innovative Building Review Committee has determined Advanced Environments' residential building to demonstrate an exceptionally high level of energy efficiency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors, honors Advanced Environments for their residential building and further commends them for the leadership in energy-efficient building design.
