**RESOLUTION HONORING TERRY DRESSLER UPON HIS  
RETIREMENT FROM THE SANTA BARBARA COUNTY  
AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, Terry Dressler has worked in the Air Pollution Control District field since 1978, having served the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District (APCD) since 1987, including serving as the APCD Control Officer since 2004; and

WHEREAS, throughout his career Terry has demonstrated leadership and vision in working to identify and implement strategies to improve air quality and ensure Santa Barbara County is in compliance with frequent changes in regulatory requirements; and

WHEREAS, Terry Dressler helped establish the APCD Community Advisory Council (CAC) whose duties include providing advice to the APCD Control Officer and Board of Directors in matters related to planning and achieving clean air standards required by federal clean air plans and rules; and


WHEREAS, in 2009 Terry Dressler served as president of the California Air Pollution Control Officers Association (CAPCOA) where he worked to guide the Association through the complex task of implementing the California Air Resources Board (ARB) Enhanced Vapor Recovery Program, and he worked with ARB staff to improve implementation of the Portable Equipment Registration Program; and

WHEREAS, Terry Dressler has provided his technical expertise, local experience and keen insight in efforts to meet and exceed Santa Barbara County's compliance with Federal and State air quality regulations. His work includes streamlining reporting requirements for local, state and federal government agencies who meet the criteria for the Exceptional Events Rule which waives penalties for exceeding federal air quality standards due to natural disasters and other one-time uncontrollable events, and working with the National Association of Counties to advocate that the U.S. EPA enhance regulations of marine shipping emissions, which are considered one of the greatest sources of air pollution in Santa Barbara County; and

WHEREAS, over his years at the District, the ponytail disappeared and was replaced by the fedora and the business suit, but Terry also became a born-again surfer who would get up before dawn on any morning when the waves were breaking just right;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors honors Terry Dressler for his 32 years of dedication to protecting public health and commends him for his efforts to implement policies to ensure clean air for the residents of Santa Barbara County.
