SUBJECT:	No Parking 2 AM to 5 AM Zones on Fairway Road, Channel Drive and Butterfly Lane, in the First Supervisorial District.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

C.A. Recommendation:

That the Board of Supervisors adopt a resolution establishing "No Parking 2 AM to 5 AM" zones on Fairway Road, Channel Drive and Butterfly Lane in the Montecito area.

ALIGNMENT WITH BOARD STRATEGIC PLAN:

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal #1: An efficient government able to anticipate and respond effectively to the needs of the community and Goal #2: Ensure the public health and safety and provide essential infrastructure.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY & DISCUSSION:

Public Works Staff has been meeting with the residents in the Butterfly Beach Association, Montecito Association, and the community to resolve traffic related concerns in Montecito. Residents requested that the County address the problem of overnight parking, and after investigation by staff and working with the residents, County staff has determined that posting no parking 2am-5am on selected streets (see vicinity map) would alleviate the overnight parking issue. Homeowners along each street have been contacted and will not be affected by the restriction due to their on-site parking availability. The Public Works Traffic Section has prepared the attached resolution to establish "No Parking 2 AM to 5 AM" zones at the following location:

- On both sides of Fairway Road, from the centerline of Channel Drive to the centerline of Channel Drive.
- On both sides of Channel Drive, from the centerline of Olive Mill Road to the centerline of Fairway Road.
- On both sides of Butterfly Lane from the centerline of Hill Road to the centerline of Channel Drive.
