He served as the lead litigator representing the Land Owner Group's water rights in the Santa Maria groundwater basin. This group continues to represent over ten thousand acres of premier agricultural land; and

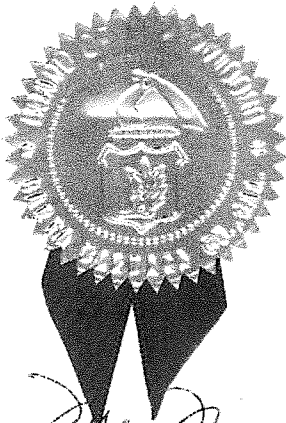
