**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA HONORING DIVISION CHIEF SERGIO SANCHEZ UPON HIS RETIREMENT FROM THE SANTA BARBARA COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, Division Chief Sergio Sanchez began his distinguished fire service career with the Santa Barbara County Fire Department in April 1993 as a Reserve Firefighter assigned to Station 31; in May 1994, hired as a full-time Firefighter and quickly demonstrated dedication, professionalism, and leadership; and

**WHEREAS**, throughout his career, Chief Sanchez served as a valued member of the XSB Type 3 Incident Management Team and responded to numerous local, state, and national emergencies, including but not limited to:

**WHEREAS**, Chief Sanchez demonstrated his commitment to labor-management partnership and firefighter advocacy through his many years of service on the Executive Board of Santa Barbara County Firefighters Local 2046; and

**WHEREAS**, Chief Sanchez served the broader community beyond emergency response, including being nominated among over 300,000 individuals and selected as one of 300 representatives by Coca-Cola to participate in the 2002 Salt Lake City Winter Olympics Torch Relay in recognition of his community involvement, mentorship, and volunteer service with Special Olympics; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1996, Chief Sanchez was honored to represent the Department as the model for the Santa Barbara County Firefighter Memorial statue, completed and placed into service in 1997, which now stands as a lasting tribute and memorial to firefighters and their service to the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara does hereby acknowledge honoring Division Chief Sergio Sanchez upon his retirement from the Santa Barbara County Fire Department.
