NATIONAL PUBLIC HEALTH WEEK
IN SANTA BARBARA COUNTY

WHEREAS, the week of April 1-7, 2019, is National Public Health Week, and the theme is "Creating the Healthiest Nation: For science. For action. For health."; and

WHEREAS, there is a significant difference in health status among people living in rural areas compared with people living in urban areas; this variance increases because rural residents are often more likely to face poverty, transportation barriers, and lack of economic opportunity; and

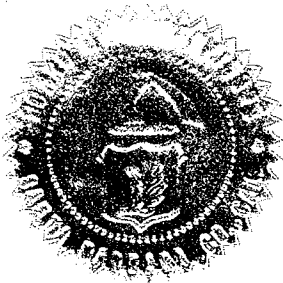
WHEREAS, 60 percent of Americans live with a preventable chronic disease and health risks such as alcoholism, obesity, and tobacco use that are the primary reason for 7 of 10 deaths annually in the U.S.; and

WHEREAS, public health action, together with scientific and technologic advances, has played a major role in reducing and in some cases eliminating the spread of infectious disease; and

WHEREAS, public health professionals help communities prevent, prepare for, withstand and recover from the impact of a full range of health threats, including disease outbreaks and natural or manmade disasters.








Supervisor - 1st District




Supervisor - 2nd District
