CIT Training – Custody



- Custody deputies receive 40 hours of CIT training in CORE academy.
- Over 40 custody deputies have received this training since 2021.

CIT Training – Patrol



- 4 hour Use of Force/De-escalation
- 4 hour Crisis
 Intervention

CIT Training – Patrol



- Mental disorders & dual diagnosis
- ID indicators of mental illness, intellectual disabilities, substance abuse disorders
- Perspective of LE interaction with mentally ill
- Non-violent intervention
- Conflict resolution
- Appropriate language usage with emotionally distressed persons
- How does 5150 work
