# CIT Training – Custody



- Custody deputies receive 40 hours of CIT training in CORE academy.
- Over 40 custody deputies have received this training since 2021.

- 4 hour Crisis Intervention

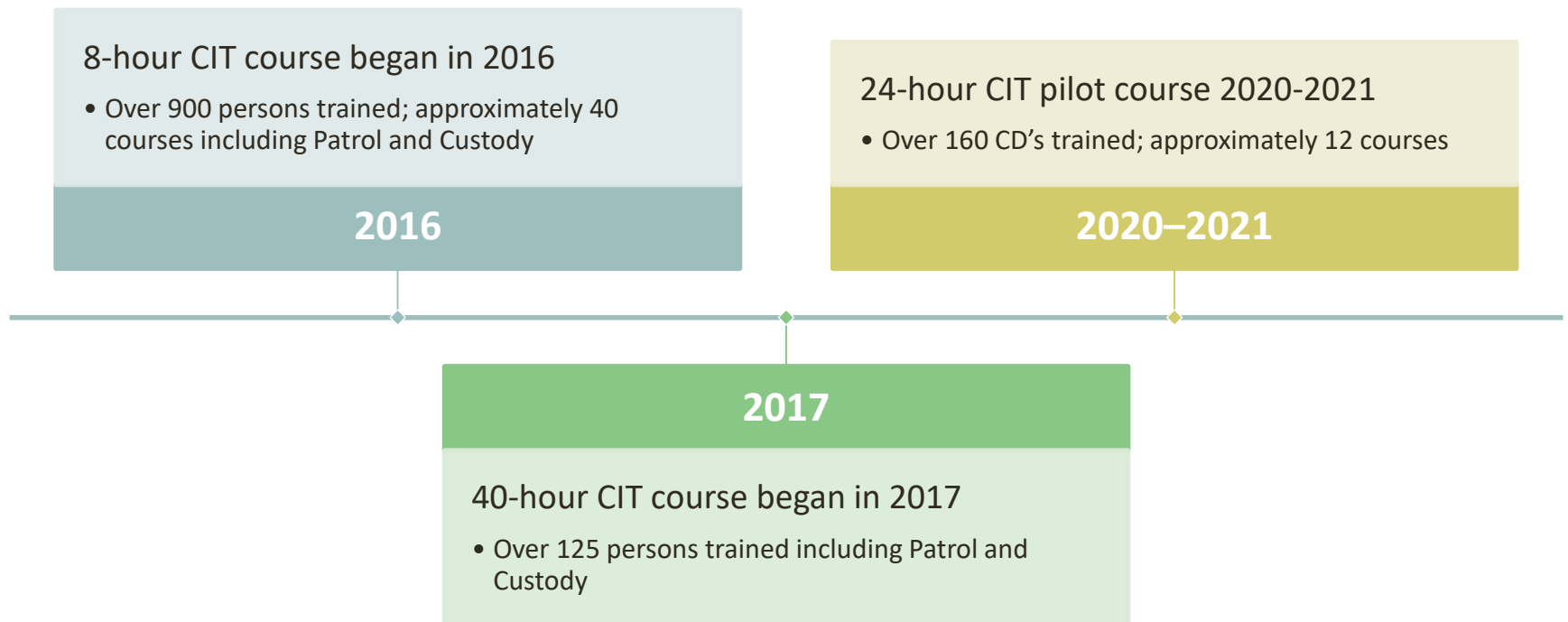
# CIT Training – Patrol

- Perspective of LE interaction with mentally ill
- Non-violent intervention
- Conflict resolution
