RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

IN THE MATTER OF REVISING THE SOLID WASTE HANDLING AND DISPOSAL FEES AT COUNTY FACILITIES, THE SOLID WASTE COLLECTION RATES CHARGED BY FRANCHISEES, AND THE SOLID WASTE PROGRAM FEE AS PROPOSED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, RESOURCE RECOVERY AND WASTE MANAGEMENT DIVISION | RESOLUTION NO. _____

WHEREAS, according to Chapter 17 of the Santa Barbara County Code, the Board of Supervisors may revise the established Solid Waste Handling and Disposal Fees charged at County facilities upon the recommendation of the Public Works Department Director; and

WHEREAS, according to Chapter 17 of the Santa Barbara County Code, the Board of Supervisors may revise the established Solid Waste Collection Rates upon the recommendation of the Public Works Department Director; and

WHEREAS, according to Chapter 17 of the Santa Barbara County Code, the Board of Supervisors may revise the established solid waste program fee upon the recommendation of the Public Works Department Director, and the Director is recommending an increase from 10% to 12% of gross receipts to fund community programs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that the revised rate schedules, Attachments A and B, will be just, fair, reasonable and sufficient to provide service to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that the revised collection rate schedules, Attachment B, will provide a reasonable return to the franchisees operating pursuant to exclusive franchise agreements in Santa Barbara County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Barbara, pursuant to state law and Chapter 17 of the Santa Barbara County Code, hereby, revises the solid waste handling and disposal fees charged at County Facilities (Attachment A), and the Collection Rates charged by the Franchisees, as presented in the schedules attached (Attachment B), and the increase of the solid waste program fee upon the recommendation of the Director of Public Works. Each of the rates established by the Resolution supersedes the rates established previously. Each of the rates established by this resolution will be effective July 1, 2011 and will continue to be in effect until revised, repealed, or otherwise amended.
