#### SECOND AMENDMENT

# VOTING SYSTEM ACQUISITION AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN DOMINION VOTING SYSTEMS, INC. AND COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA

This Second Amendment to the Voting System Acquisition Agreement ("Second Amendment") is made and entered into as of the date signed by the County of Santa Barbara (the "Second Amendment Effective Date") by and between the County of Santa Barbara ("Customer") and Dominion Voting Systems, Inc. ("Dominion")

#### **RECITALS**

**WHEREAS,** effective September 17, 2019, the Customer and Dominion entered into a Voting System and Services Agreement (the "Original Agreement");

**WHEREAS,** effective April 30, 2020, the Customer and Dominion entered into a First Amendment to the Voting System and Services Agreement ("First Amendment");

WHEREAS, the Customer and Dominion desire to amend the Agreement; and

**THEREFORE,** in consideration of the mutual covenants and obligations herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, the Customer and Dominion agree as follows:

### **AMENDMENT**

- 1. **Recitals Incorporated.** The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth.
- **2. Amendment of Exhibit C**. Section 4.1 of Exhibit C is hereby amended to read as follows:
  - "The total amount paid under this Agreement, including cost reimbursements, is not to exceed \$3,500,000. This total amount includes the amounts in Exhibits C, C-1 and C-2."
- **3.** Addition of Exhibit C-2. Exhibit C-2, attached hereto and incorporated by this reference, is hereby added to the Agreement immediately following Exhibit C-1. All references to "Exhibit C" in the Agreement are hereby replaced with references to "Exhibit C, Exhibit C-1 and Exhibit C-2."
- **4. Addition to Exhibit A**. The deliverables described in Exhibits C-1 and C-2 are added to Exhibit A, Statement of Work.
- **5. Substitution of Customer Representative**. Paragraphs 3 and 29 of the Agreement and Section 4.3 of Exhibit A to the Agreement are amended to change the Customer Representative from "Renee Bischof" to "Michael Daly." The e-mail address in Section 4.3 of Exhibit A is changed to mdaly@countyofsb.org.

**6. Additional Terms**. The following paragraphs are hereby added to the Agreement following Paragraph 48 thereof:

# 49. Prohibition on Certain Telecommunications and Video Surveillance Services or Equipment

- 1. Dominion is prohibited from obligating or expending loan or grant funds to:
  - a. Procure or obtain;
  - b. Extend or renew a contract to procure or retain; or
  - c. Enter into a contract (or extend or renew a contract)

to procure or obtain equipment, services, or systems that use covered telecommunications equipment or services as a substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system.

- 2. As described in Public Law 115-232, section 889, covered telecommunications equipment or services means the following:
  - a. Telecommunications equipment produced by Huawei Technologies Company or ZTE Corporation (or any subsidiary or affiliate of such entities).
  - b. For the purposes of public safety, security of government facilities, physical security surveillance of critical infrastructure, and other national security purposes, video surveillance and telecommunications equipment produced by Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company, or Dahua Technology Company (or any subsidiary or affiliate of such entities).
  - c. Telecommunications or video surveillance services provided by such entities or using such equipment.
  - d. Telecommunications or video surveillance equipment or services produced or provided by an entity that the Secretary of Defense, in consultation with the Director of the National Intelligence or the Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation, reasonably believes to be an entity owned or controlled by, or otherwise connected to, the government of a covered foreign country.

#### 50. Domestic Preferences for Procurement.

1. As appropriate and to the extent consistent with law, Dominion should, to the greatest extent practicable under a Federal award, provide a preference for the purchase, acquisition, or use of goods, products, or materials produced in the United States (including but not limited to iron, aluminum, steel, cement, and other manufactured products). The requirements of this section must be included in all subawards including all contracts and purchase orders for work or products under this award.

- 2. For purposes of this section:
  - a. "Produced in the United States" means, for iron and steel products, that all manufacturing processes, from the initial melting stage through the application of coatings, occurred in the United States.
  - b. "Manufactured products" means items and construction materials composed in whole or in part of non-ferrous metals such as aluminum; plastics and polymer-based products such as polyvinyl chloride pipe; aggregates such as concrete; glass, including optical fiber; and lumber.
- **7. All Other Terms**. Except as expressly amended in this Second Amendment, all other Agreement terms shall remain in full force and effect.
- **8.** Execution in Counterparts. The Second Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts and each of such counterparts shall for all purposes be deemed to be an original; and all such counterparts, or as many of them as the parties shall preserve undestroyed, shall together constitute one and the same instrument.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF,** the parties have executed this Second Amendment to the Agreement to be effective as of the Second Amendment Effective Date.
