RESOLUTION OF COMMENDATION FOR CHRISTOPHER PACE FOR ATTAINING THE RANK OF EAGLE SCOUT

WHEREAS, Christopher Pace has been involved in Boy Scouts for 10 years of his life and has achieved the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest a scout can receive and achieved by less than 2% of all Boy Scouts; and

WHEREAS, Christopher's scouting trips and service projects have helped him to learn about life and to adapt to different situations. He lives by the Boy Scout oath and law everyday of his life; and

WHEREAS, Christopher's Service Project required him to plan, develop and complete a project that was helpful to a worthy institution and brought value to his local community. Christopher chose to build a Prayer Walk at the Santa Ynez Valley Presbyterian Church, consisting of an 800 foot long path up a hill to a 10'x10' deck with seats overlooking the beautiful Santa Ynez Valley. Christopher planned, purchased the materials for, constructed, organized and supervised 39 volunteers from the church, community, and Boy Scout troop to complete the project. There were 324 hours of volunteer work involved in the project; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Pace is an honor student at Santa Ynez, Valley High School and a member of the California Scholastic Federation. He is involved in water polo, soccer and swimming, and was named Most Valuable Player for his High School's swim team in 2001. He is also an avid surfer and snowboarder; and

WHEREAS, Christopher Pace's goals are to join the Air Force Academy and eventually become an astronaut. He plans to pursue his pilot's license this summer.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors acknowledges the remarkable accomplishments of Christopher Pace and congratulates him for his personal achievement in becoming an Eagle Scout.
