Add a regular meeting for Tuesday December 23, 2008 in Santa Barbara.

Summary:

On November 13, 2008, the Director of Emergency Services proclaimed that a State of Emergency existed due to threats posed by the Tea Fire. The Tea Fire ultimately consumed approximately 1,940 acres and preliminary damage estimates are that approximately 211 residences in both the city and the county were destroyed. As a result of this damage, Governor Schwarzenegger proclaimed a State of Emergency; which remains in effect. On November 18, 2008, President Bush declared a major disaster for the southern California wildfires; including Santa Barbara County; which also remains in effect.

The resolution reaffirming the ongoing existence of local emergency due to environmental impacts,

response and recovery costs from the Tea Fire must be considered and adopted every two weeks. The

adopted 2008 meeting schedule of the Board of Supervisors does not include meetings on December 23,

2008 or on December 30, 2008. To facilitate the continued affirmation of the ongoing existence of local

emergency, staff is recommending the addition of a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors for

Tuesday, December 23, 2008 in Santa Barbara.

December 23, 2008 falls within the timeframe established for the implementation of the Mandatory

Furlough Program As such, staff does not anticipate placing any additional matters on the agenda for

this meeting and will not do so except as otherwise directed by the Board of Supervisors and the County

Executive Officer.
