**Executive Summary and Discussion:**

The Santa Barbara County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) has requested that individuals interested in serving on LAFCO as a public member representative submit applications to the LAFCO Executive Officer by February 4, 2005. This vacant position was created due to the resignation of public member Tom Umenhofer. The individual appointed to this position will fill a term set to expire on March 1, 2009.

Applications received by the LAFCO Executive Officer will be reviewed by an ad hoc committee of LAFCO members who will review all applications and make recommendations regarding the appointment to the entire Commission.

The LAFCO Executive Officer has released a public announcement advising members of the public of the opening and providing the appropriate details regarding the application process. Additionally, interested individuals are encouraged to visit the LAFCO web site at [www.sblafco.org](http://www.sblafco.org) for an application as well as further information regarding LAFCO and the public member position. Attached to this Board Letter is a copy of the application and the public announcement regarding this position.
