Recommended Actions: 1. Approve the appointment and reappointment of the individuals listed to serve on the Santa Barbara County Workforce Investment Board for the term indicated on the attached roster.

Summary Text:

The Santa Barbara County Workforce Investment Board (WIB) is mandated by the Federal Workforce Investment Act (WIA), Public Law 105-220. The WIB Members, many of whom represent public entities mandated to sit on the WIB by the Act, are appointed by the Board of Supervisors and serve for specific terms. As their appointed terms of service expire, they must be reappointed for a new term, with the WIB nominating committee working with the WIB Executive Director to forward names to the Board. The attached list contains names of current WIB Members who are being reappointed, as well as new members who will be serving their first term.

Background: The WIB develops workforce policy for the county, and oversees the operation of two One-Stop Career Centers, and the employment & training programs for youth, recently laid-off workers, and the unemployed adults. In addition, the WIB fosters a working relationship with the business community to assist it with current labor market information and other workforce intelligence, such as industry sector initiatives and research. Finally, the WIB has appointed a Youth Advisory Council (YAC) that advises the larger body on youth program issues, and the selection of youth program training providers.

The Workforce Investment Act mandates that several public entities sit on the WIB. Among these "Mandated Partners" is the publicly-funded State Job Service, local economic development entities,

the senior program provider, the Department of Rehabilitation, the Community Service Block Grant administrator, and representatives of the local educational system (community colleges). In addition, the Federal law stipulates that a majority of the WIB must be from the private sector, while California State Law states that 20% of the membership must represent organized labor.

The State of California, who monitors the local WIBs and WIA programs annually, validates the membership composition, and with the current reappointments, the Santa Barbara WIB fulfills many of the legislative requirements. Moreover, the WIB Executive Director and Board Members are actively engaged in recruitment; thus, more new appointments will be made in the coming months. The objective is to have all Mandated Partner seats filled by July 1, 2009.
