**SUBJECT:** Authorize the Director of Public Works to advertise for the Tajiguas Landfill West Side 48-Inch Storm Drain Replacement 2005 Project, county project No. 828718, Third Supervisorial District.

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**Recommendation(s):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

- A. Approve the Notice of Exemption pursuant to Section 15302 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines.
- B. Authorize the Director of Public Works to advertise for the Tajiguas Landfill West Side 48-inch Storm Drain Replacement 2005 Project, county project No. 828718.

**Alignment with Board Strategic Plan:**

The recommendation is primarily aligned with Goal No. 2, A Safe and Healthy Community in Which to Live, Work, and Visit.

**Executive Summary and Discussion:**

A corrugated metal pipe diverting Pila Creek from the Tajiguas Landfill filling operations has reached the end of its service life and shown signs of corrosion. It is to be replaced with a long-lasting and resilient high-density polyethylene pipe. 900 Feet of pipe will be replaced in this project. This is the third and final section of pipe to be replaced. The new pipe will meet all regulatory requirements and will be located off the waste footprint. The proposed schedule will be to solicit bids during March 2005, with construction commencing in the beginning of June 2005. The project was found to be exempt from CEQA under Section No. 15302, Replacement of Existing Facilities.

**Mandates and Service Levels:**

This project will not change the level of service.

**Fiscal and Facilities Impacts:**

Funds for this project have been budgeted into the Solid Waste Enterprise Fund 1930, Acct. 8200.
