WHEREAS, Daniel H. Duffy, Jr. will be retiring from County service on Sunday, October 12, 2014, having faithfully served the Sheriff's Office for over 30 (thirty) years, during which he served as a Corrections Officer and a Custody Deputy, Special Duty; and

WHEREAS, Daniel H. Duffy, Jr. started his career with Santa Barbara County on February 28, 1983, as a Corrections Officer in the Main Jail. In 1991, he was promoted to Custody Deputy, Special Duty and was assigned to the Honor Farm, and in 2001, he was assigned to the Sheriff's Human Resources Office; and

WHEREAS, Daniel H. Duffy, Jr., throughout his career, provided the employees of the Sheriff's Office positive attitude, leadership and professionalism; dedicating the latter half of his career to recruiting and conducting background investigations of the most qualified law enforcement professionals. His investigations resulted in the hiring of approximately two-hundred and twentyfive (225) employees; and

Duffy, Jr. provided the citizens of Santa Barbara County extraordinary professionalism and leadership, devoting his personal time to assist with youth sport activities, as a referee, and as an announcer for Cabrillo High School Junior Varsity and Varsity sports, where he has earned the title of "The voice of the Conquistadors". Daniel H. Duffy, Jr., is a youth sports coach dedicated to developing and mentoring our community's youth in the spirit of sportsmanship, to be healthy and productive members of society.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED that this Board of Supervisors commends Daniel H. Duffy, Jr. for his faithful and distinguished service to the citizens of Santa Barbara County, congratulates him upon his retirement, and wishes him and his wife Deanna, continued good health and many years of happiness.
