WHEREAS, the Code of Santa Barbara County, California, Section 23-11, as amended by Ordinance No. 1824, authorizes the Board of Supervisors of the County by Resolution, to designate portions of roads and highways under its as a “Parallel Parking” zone with “Disabled Persons Parking” Zones; and

WHEREAS, it appears to be in the best interest of public safety that certain portions of County highways in Santa Barbara County be designated as a “Parallel Parking” zone with “Disabled Persons Parking”, in accordance with said Section; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED, that the following location in Santa Barbara County and under the jurisdiction of the Board of Supervisors of said County is hereby designated as a Disabled Persons Parking Zone:

- On the south side of Lillie Avenue, beginning at a point 235 feet west of the centerline of Valencia Road, ending at a point 260 feet west of the centerline of Valencia Road
- On the north side of Lillie Avenue, beginning at a point 125 feet east of the centerline of Hollister Street, ending at a point 140 feet east of the centerline of Hollister Street

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Santa Barbara County Director of Public Works or designee is hereby authorized and directed to designate said locations with appropriate markings and/or signposts as time and resources permit.
