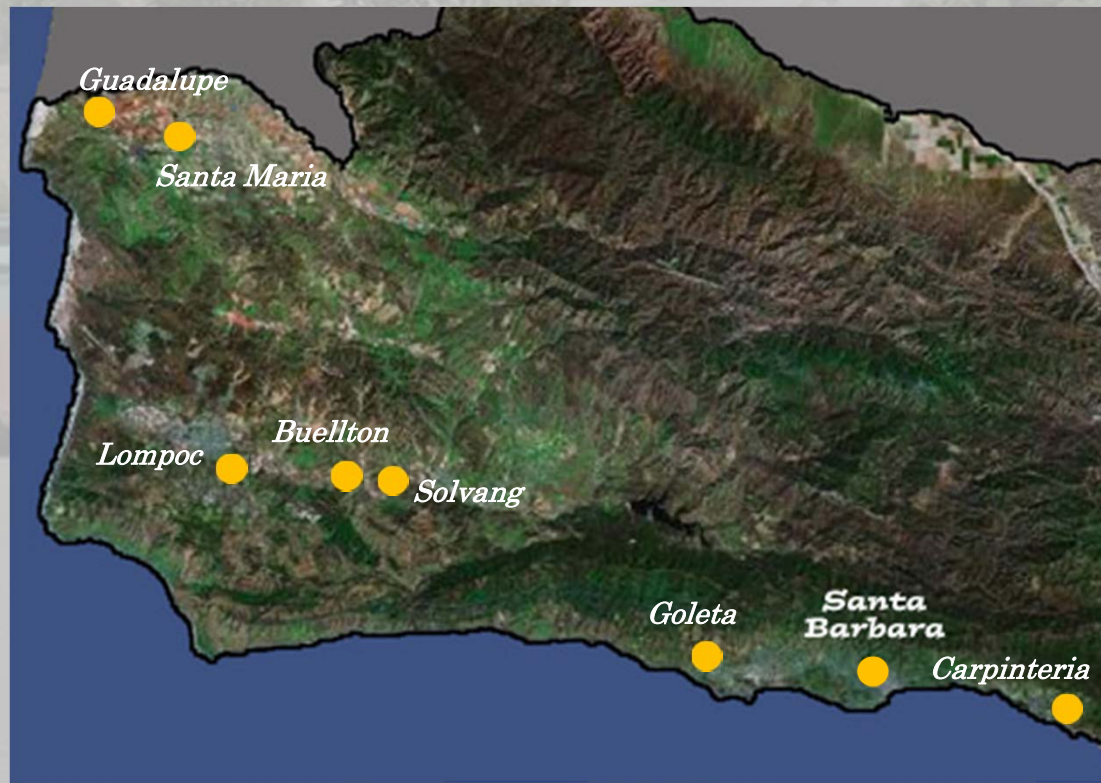

# SURROUNDING COUNTIES

- All Counties surrounding Santa Barbara have 72 –hour parking limits – San Luis Obispo, Kern, Ventura and Los Angeles.
- Santa Barbara County is the only Agency in the area to have 120 – hour parking limits



# CITIES WITHIN OUR COUNTY



- All cities within Santa Barbara County have 72-hour parking limits.



# TICKETING & TOWING PROCEDURE

1. CHP receives a complaint of a parking violation
2. CHP tags the vehicle, which starts the 72-hour clock
3. After 72 hours, CHP tickets the vehicle
4. CHP may tow the vehicle after another 72 hours



# RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

**That the Board of Supervisors:**

- A. Consider the adoption of an Ordinance amending Chapter 23 of the Santa Barbara County Code, to restrict parking to a 72-hour limits; and**
- B. Find that the proposed action is for the operation, leasing or licensing of an existing public structures, facilities, mechanical equipment or topographical feature, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond that which presently exists, and is therefore exempt from CEQA pursuant to 14 CCR 15301(c); and**
- C. Approve the filing of a Notice of Exemption.**
